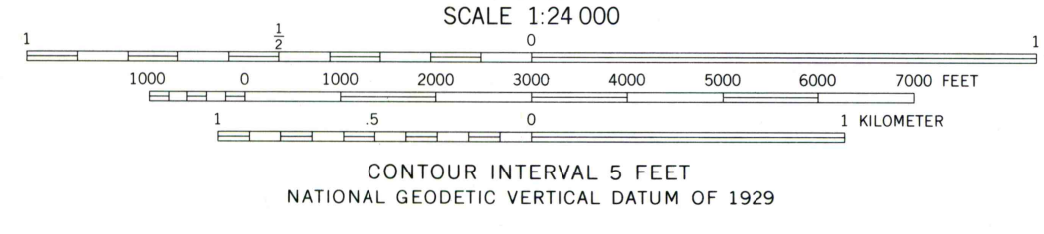
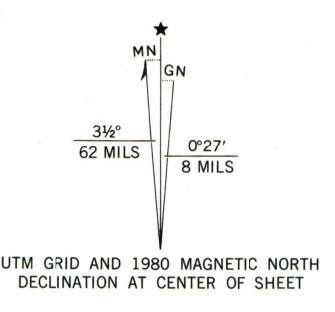

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 13 meters south and 19 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks  
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked  
Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown  
Short dashed blue lines indicate elliptical bay outlines visible on aerial photographs
