

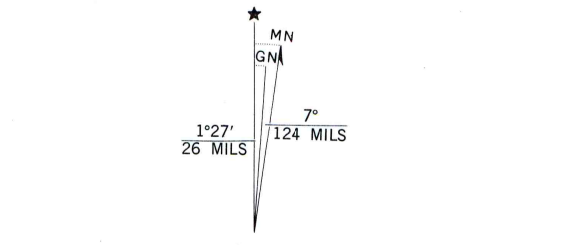

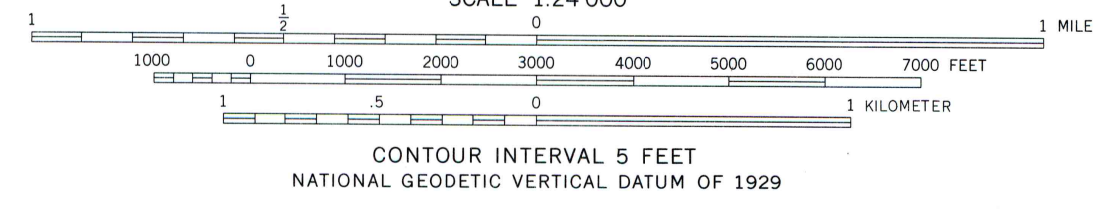
Polycyclic projection: 1927 North American datum
