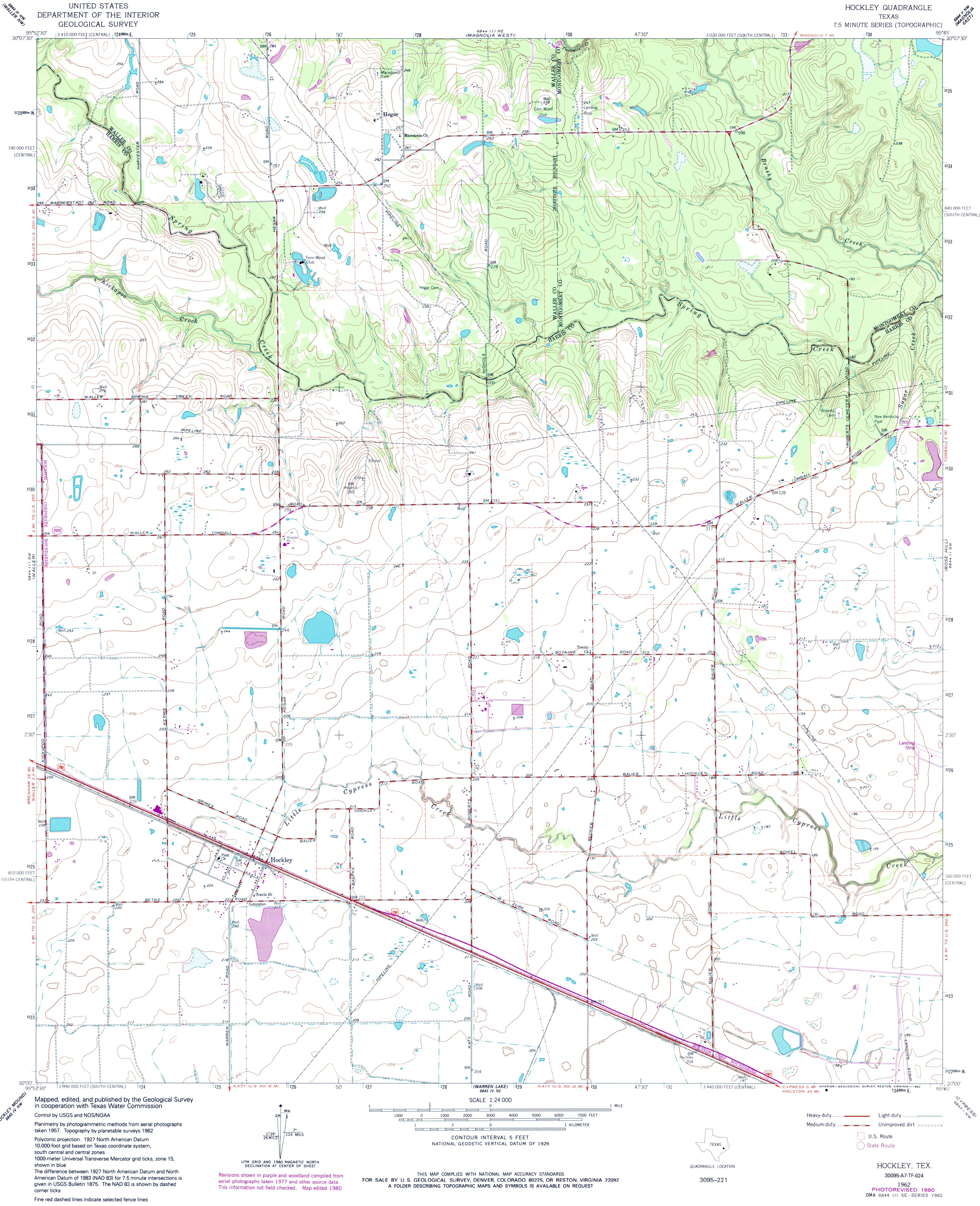

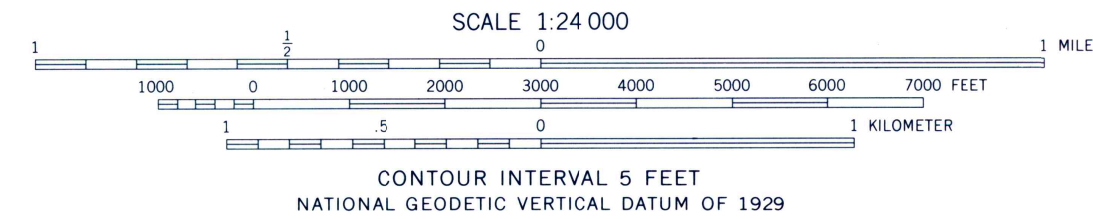
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American Datum 10,000-foot grid based on Texas coordinate system, south central and central zones
