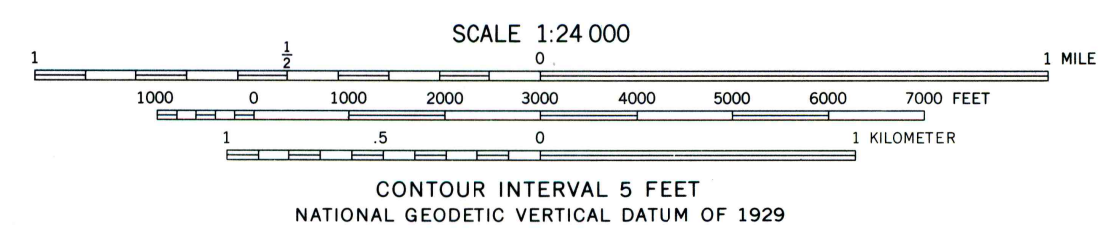
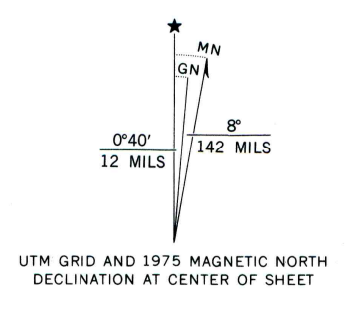




Water stages in this area vary with meteorological conditions.
