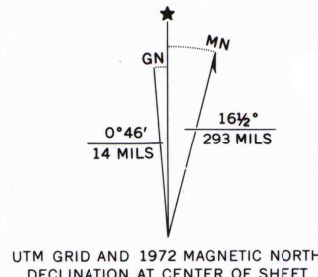

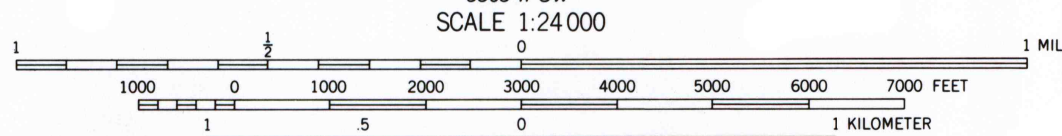
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 12, shown in blue

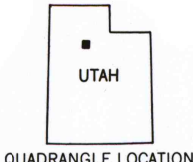
UTM GRID AND 1992 MAGNETIC NORTH DECLINATION AT CENTER OF SHEET
