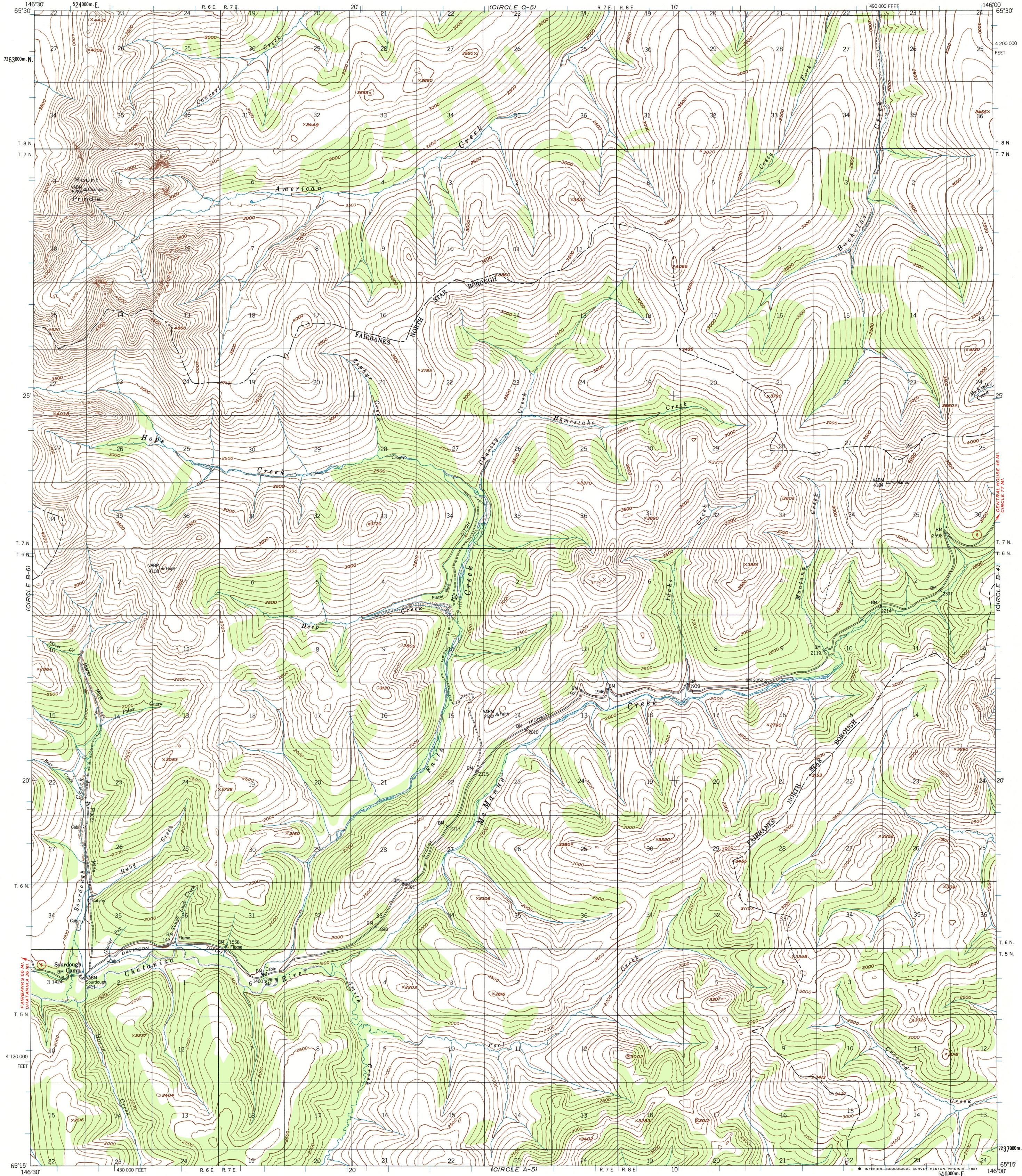

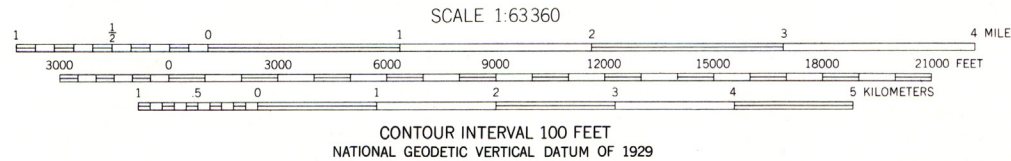
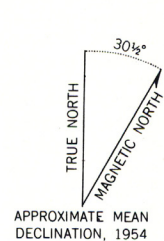
CIRCLE (B-5) QUADRANGLE
