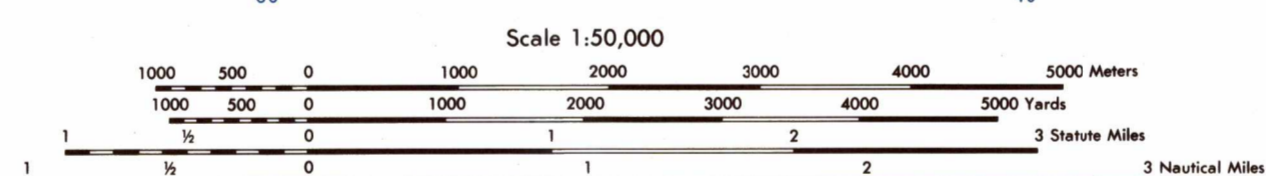


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LEGEND and SIGNOS CONVENCIONALES. This section contains symbols and descriptions for various map features. It is organized into columns: ROADS (Autopista, Carretera, etc.), CAMINOS (Caminos, etc.), Power transmission line, Línea de transmisión, and other symbols like fences, buildings, and terrain features.

CLARKE 1866 TRANSVERSA DE MERCATOR A 1,000 METROS ZONA 17. This section provides technical details about the map's projection and datum, including information about the Clarke 1866 spheroid and the North American 1927 datum.

100 METER REFERENCE. This section includes diagrams and instructions for using the 100-meter grid. It shows how to read grid coordinates and provides examples of how to report a location using the grid system.
