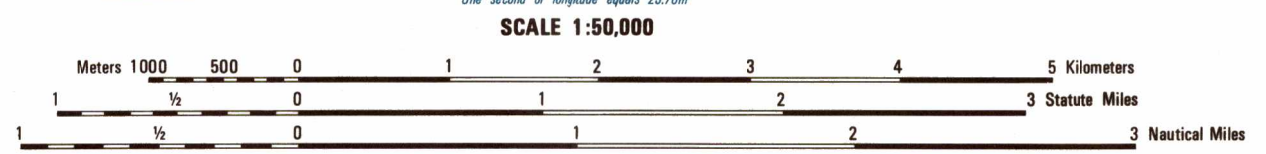

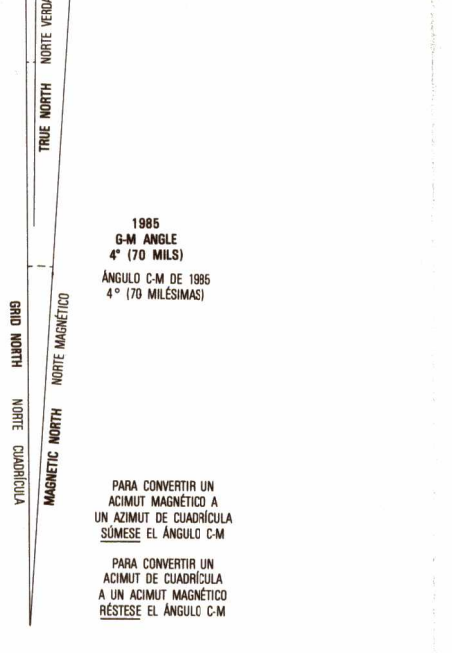
LEGEND SIGNOS CONVENCIONALES
