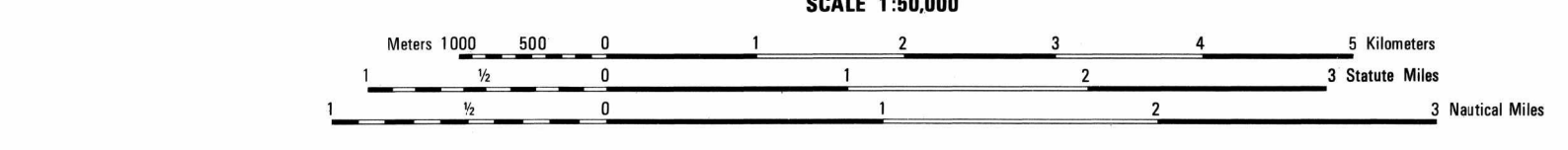

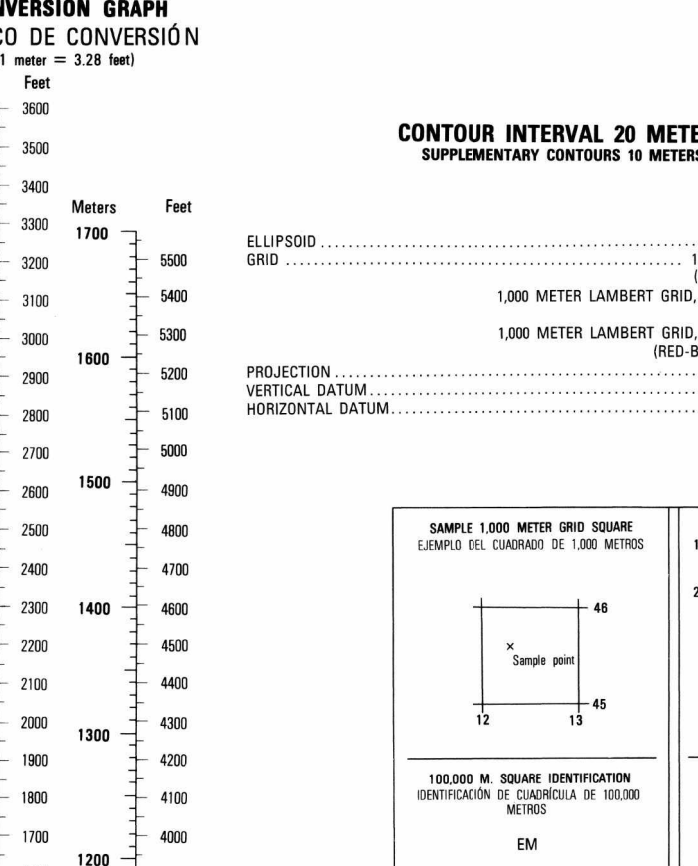

PLANERIAS. Table listing symbols for various types of buildings and structures.

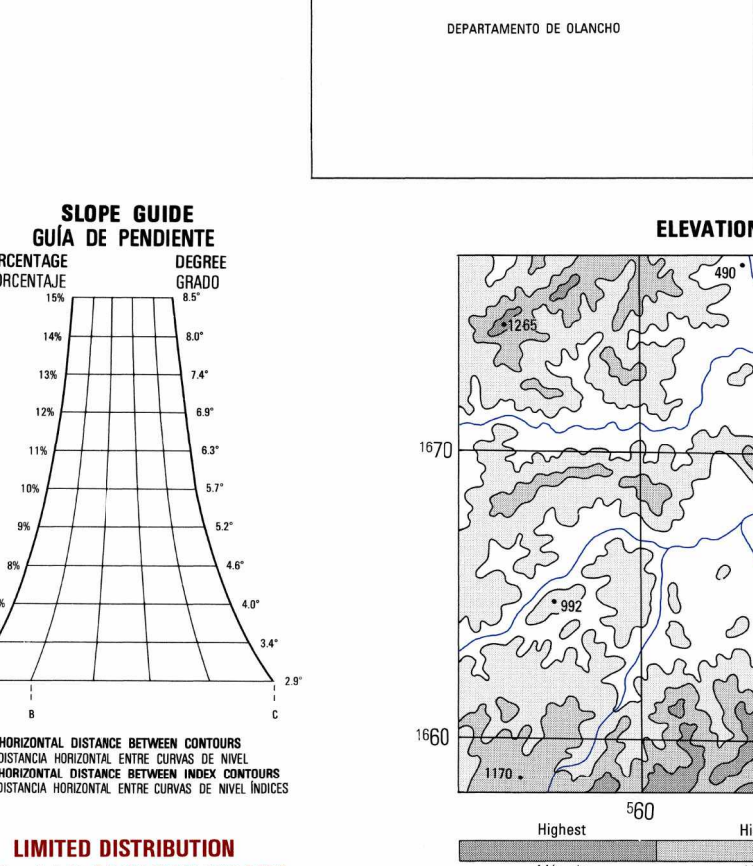
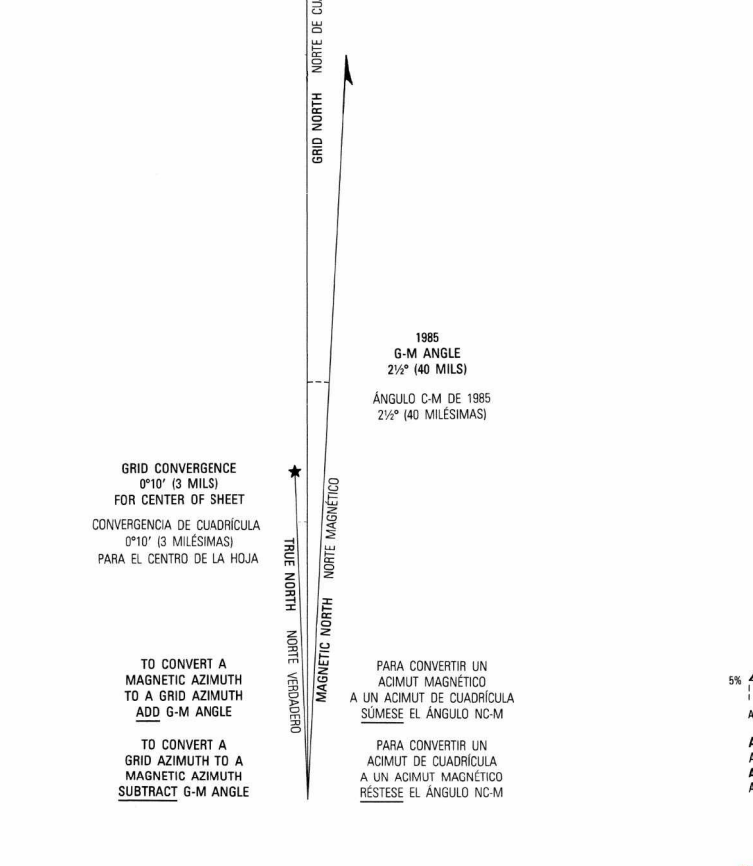
