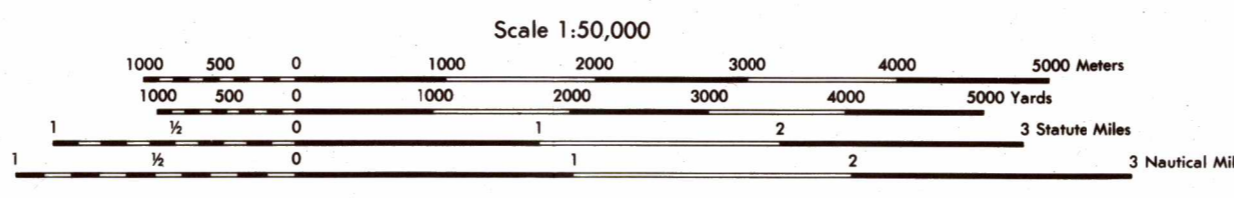

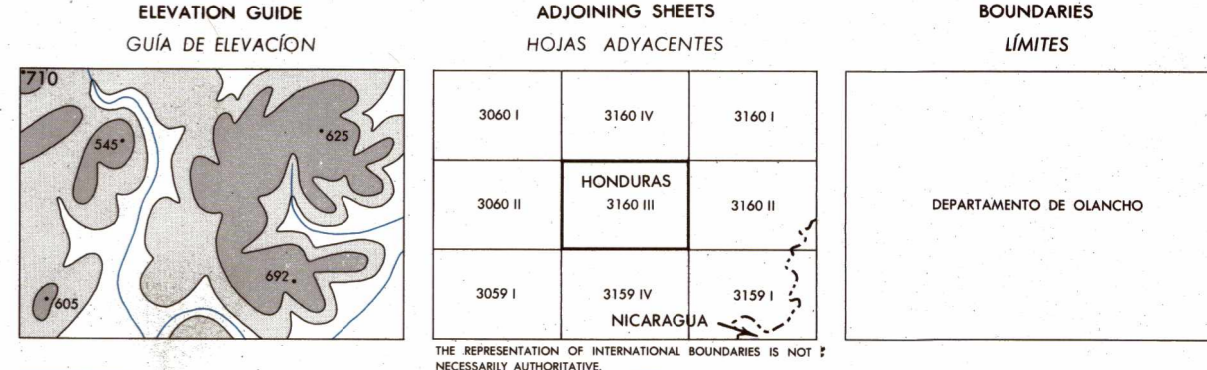
MAP INFORMATION AS OF 1970
