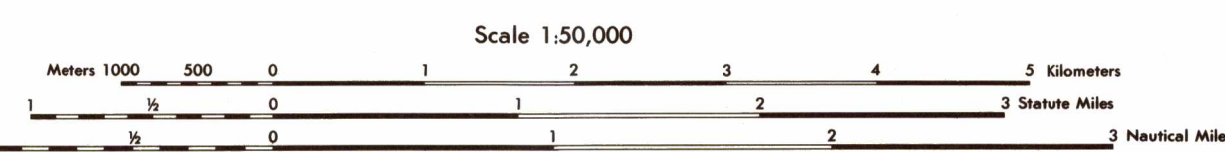




GLOSSARY GLOSARIO. A table listing geographical and man-made features in Spanish and English, such as 'Agua' (water), 'Alta tensión' (high tension power line), 'Bahía' (bay), etc.

SIGNOS CONVENCIONALES. A table defining symbols for various geographical features and infrastructure, such as 'Power transmission line', 'Fence', 'Building', etc.

CONTOUR INTERVAL 20 METERS. Includes a diagram of a grid square and instructions for reading the map's grid system, including UTM and grid zone designations.
