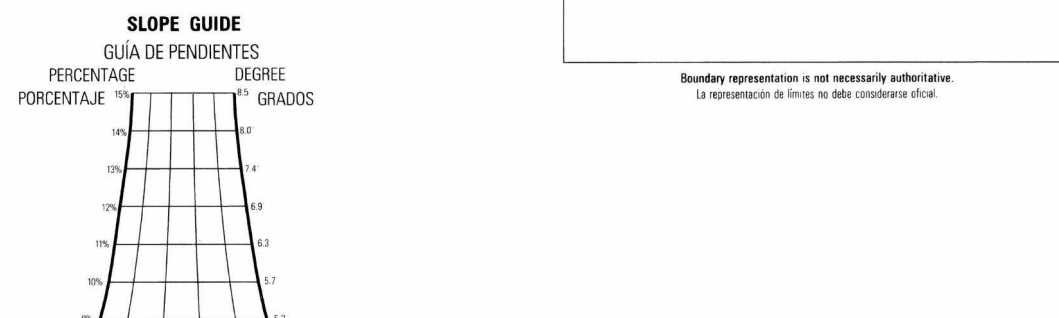

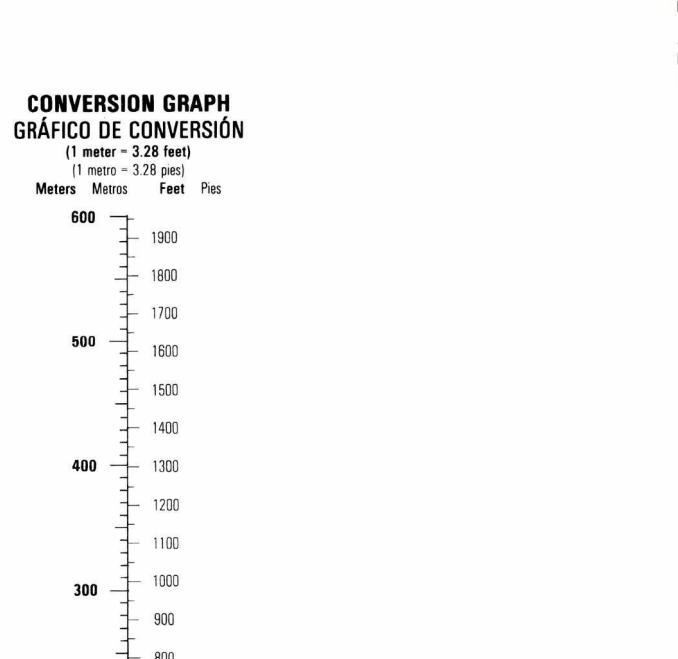
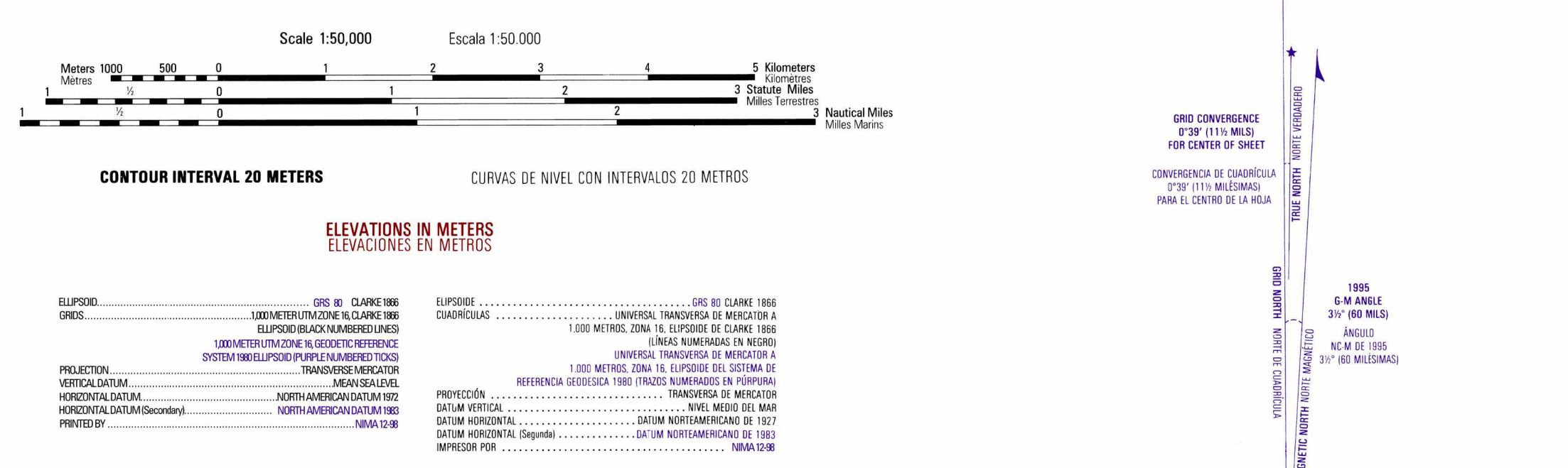


ADJOINING SHEETS HOJAS ADYACENTES. A grid showing the layout of map sheets around the current sheet, including sheet numbers and names.
