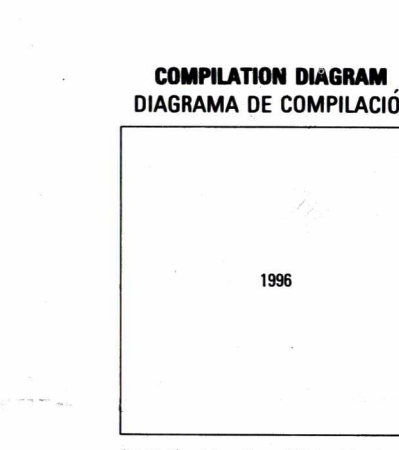


GLOSSARY (GLOSARIO). A table listing various geographical and man-made features with their corresponding symbols used on the map.
