- ROADS: Symbols for all-weather, hard surface roads, and unpaved roads.
- RAILROADS: Symbols for normal gauge and narrow gauge lines.
- BOUNDARIES: Symbols for international and administrative boundaries.
- MISCELLANEOUS CULTURAL FEATURES: Symbols for cemeteries, buildings, and other cultural features.
- RELIEF: Symbols for depression, escarpment, and other relief features.

- LEGENDA LEYENDA: Symbols for dams, spot elevations, horizontal contours, and aerodromical data.
- NOTES NOTA: Information regarding the width of a lane, the use of the map, and the coordinate system.
- LEGEND LEYENDA (continued): Symbols for streams, lakes, and other water features.
- LEGEND LEYENDA (continued): Symbols for area features like swamps and scattered trees.
- LEGEND LEYENDA (continued): Symbols for relief features like woodlands and eroded surfaces.

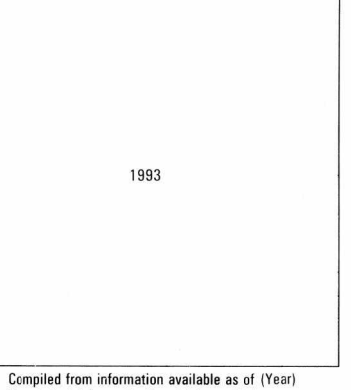
