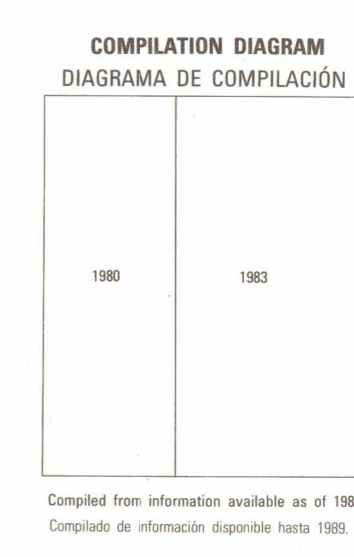


GLOSSARY GLOSARIO. A table listing symbols used on the map and their corresponding names in English and Spanish. Symbols include Departmento, Estación, Ouedo, Ouedo Rural, and Tanques.
