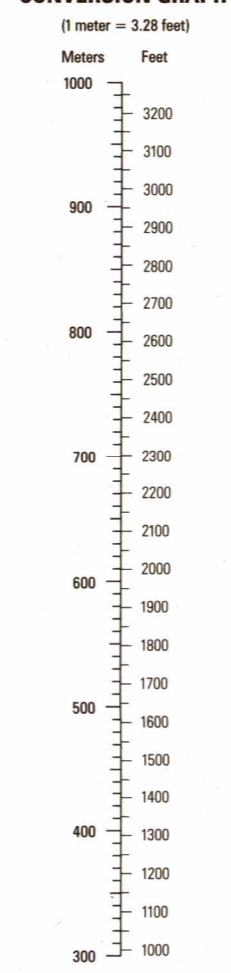
NOTES

IN DEVELOPED AREAS ONLY THROUGH ROADS ARE CLASSIFIED.
A ONE LANE ROAD IS FROM 2.5 TO LESS THAN 5.0 METERS (8 TO 16 FEET) WIDE. FOR ROADS TWO OR MORE LANES WIDE, A LANE IS CONSIDERED TO BE FROM 2.7 TO 4.1 METERS (9 TO 13 FEET).

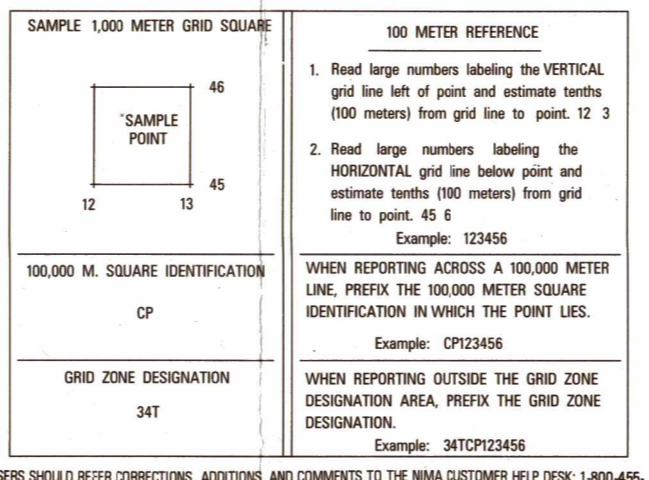

CONTOUR INTERVAL 20 METERS

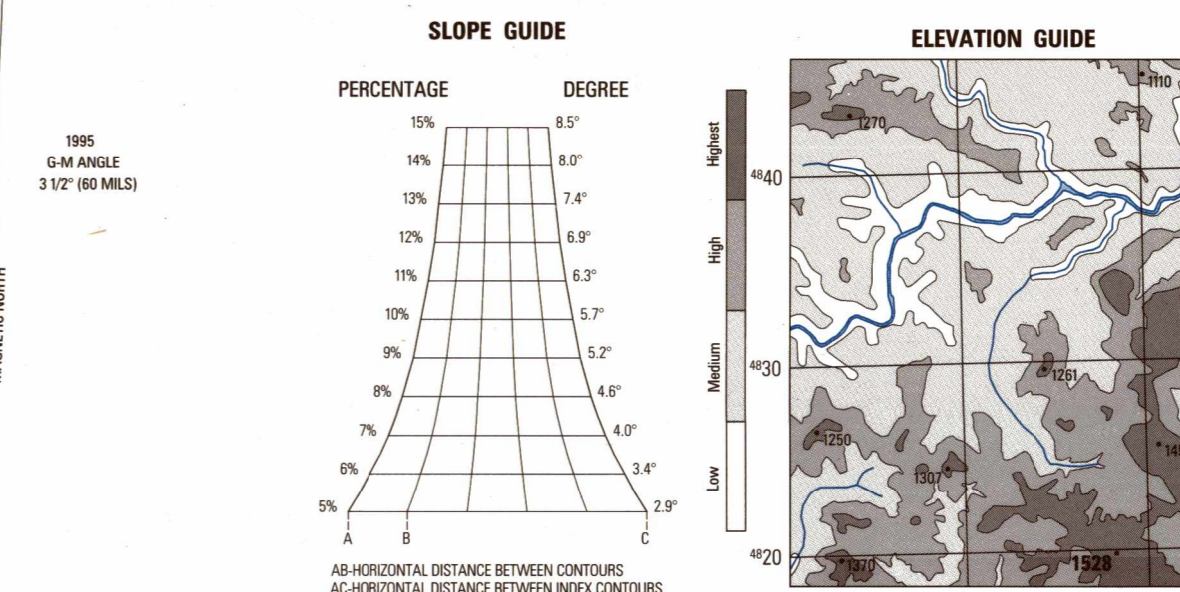
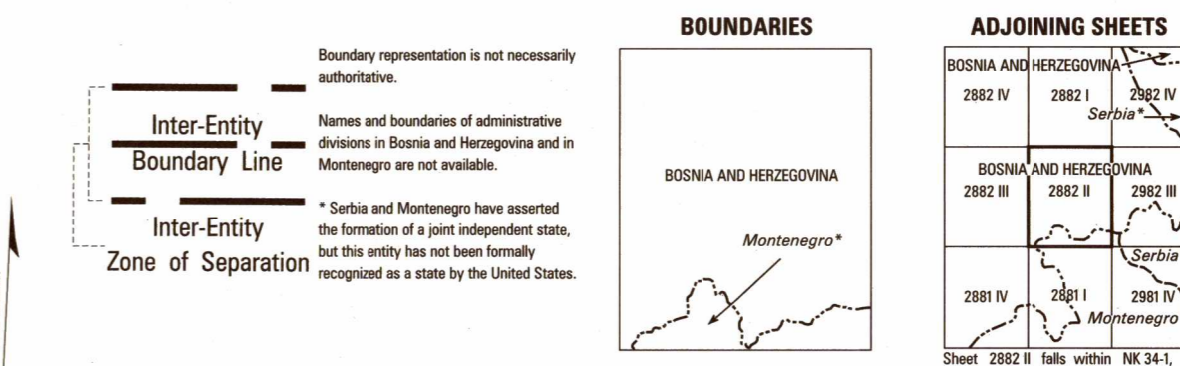
