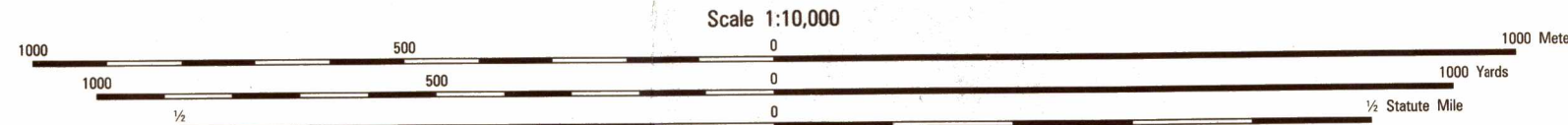

Normal railroad gauge is 1.44 meters (4' 8 1/2").

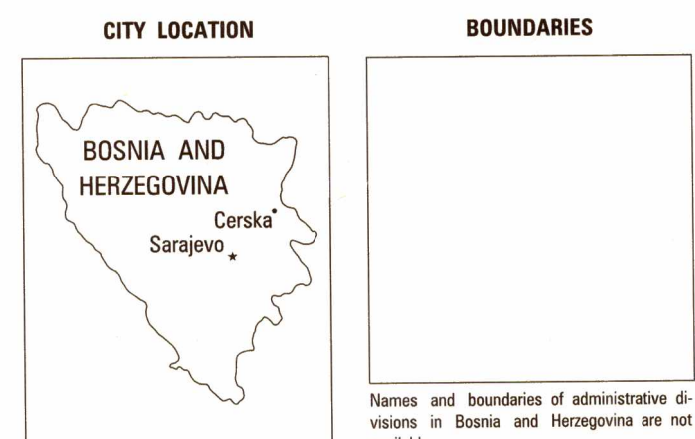
