- POPULATED PLACES: Densely built-up areas, Sparingly to moderately built-up areas
  - ROADS: Divided highway, All weather, hard surface, Two or more lanes wide, One lane wide, All weather, loose or light surface, Two or more lanes wide, One lane wide
  - OBSTRUCTIONS: Elevation of obstruction top above sea level, Elevation of obstruction top above ground level, High tension power line, communication tower
  - BOUNDARIES: International, First-order administrative division
  - RELIEF: Bluff, cliff, escarpment, Depression, Level, Sand, Spot elevation, Highest, Normal
