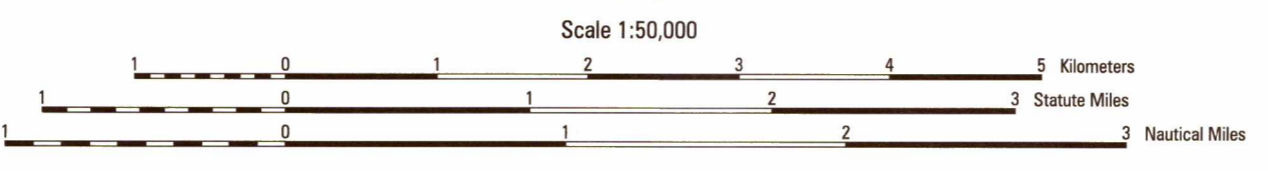

- Read large numbers labeling the VERTICAL grid line left of point and estimate tenths (100 meters) from grid line to point. Example: 123.2
- Read large numbers labeling the HORIZONTAL grid line below point and estimate tenths (100 meters) from grid line to point. Example: 45.6

WHEN REPORTING ACROSS A 100,000 METER LINE, PREFIX THE 100,000 METER SQUARE IDENTIFICATION BY WHICH YOU ARE USING.

WHEN REPORTING OUTSIDE THE GRID ZONE DESIGNATION AREA, PREFIX THE GRID ZONE DESIGNATION.
