

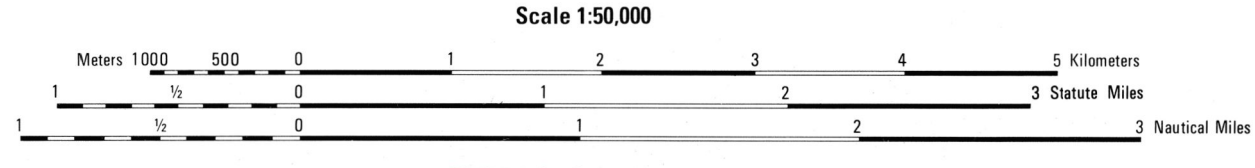

- LEGEND: POPULATED PLACES, ROADS, RAILROADS, BRIDGES, MISCELLANEOUS CULTURAL FEATURES

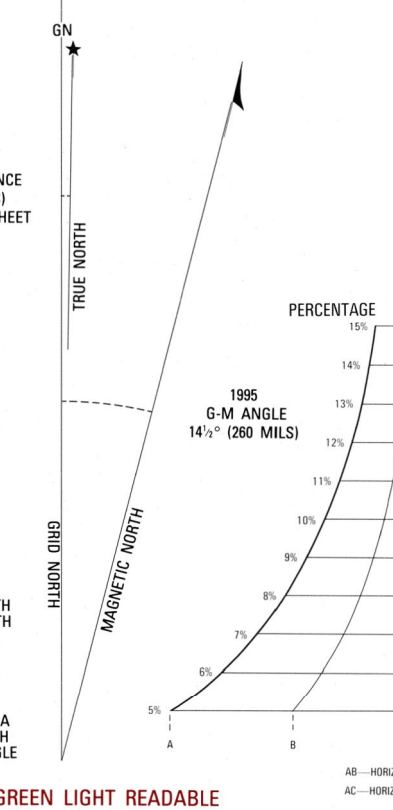
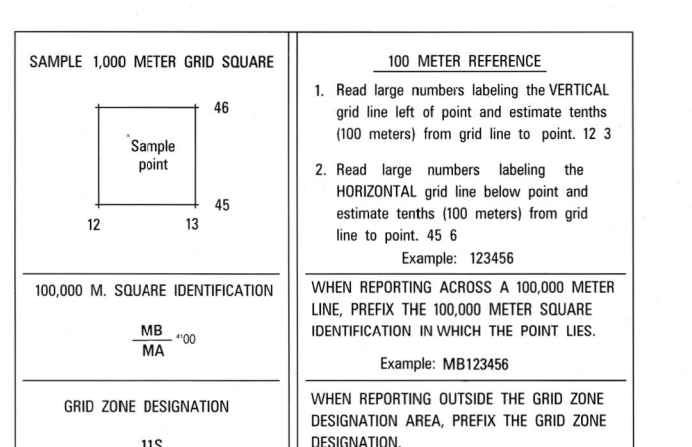
