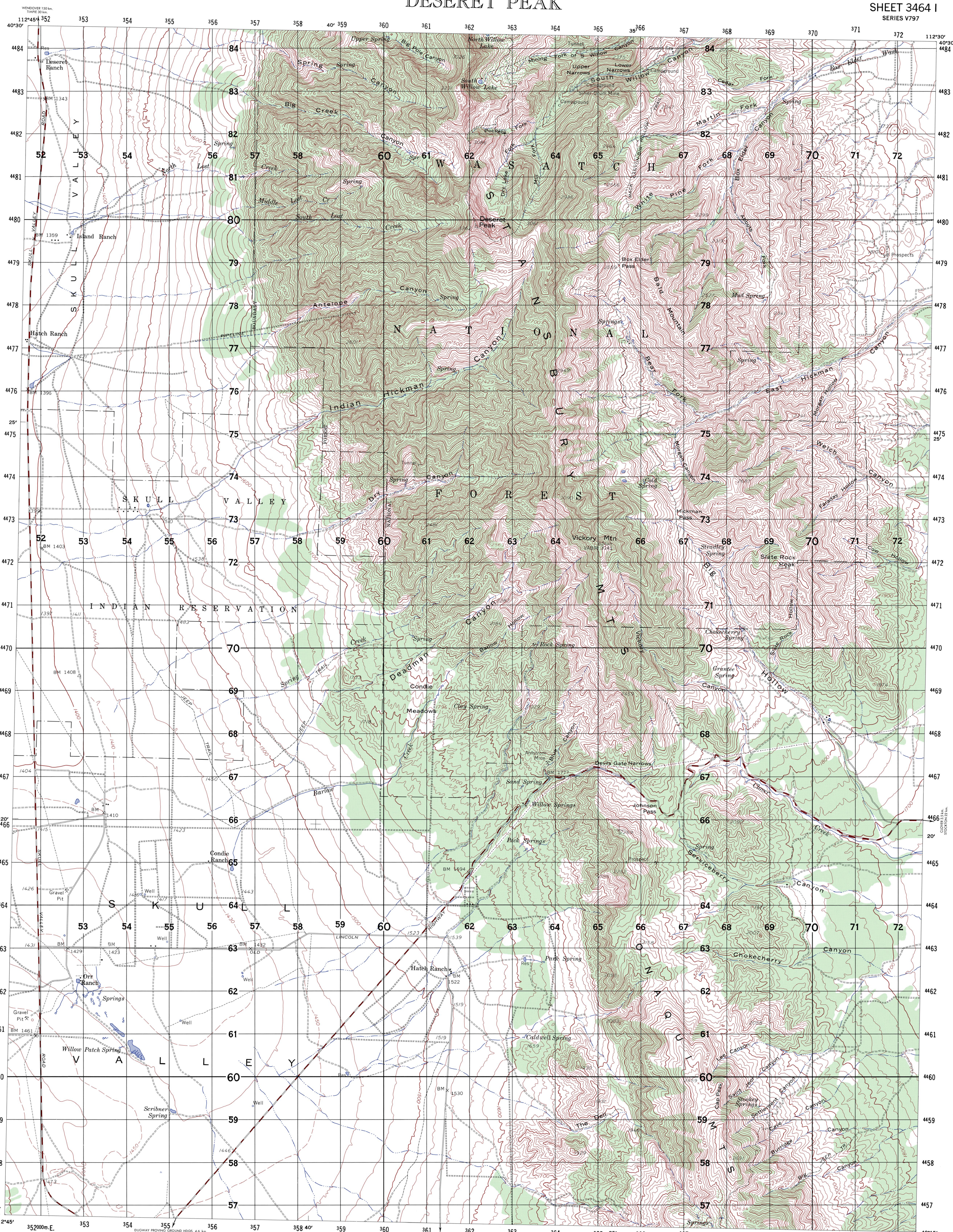

GRID ZONE DESIGNATION	TO GIVE A STANDARD REFERENCE ON THIS SHEET TO NEAREST 100 METERS
12T	SAMPLE POINT: PARK SPRING
12T	1. Read letters identifying 100,000 meter square in which the point lies.
12T	2. Locate first VERTICAL grid line to LEFT of point and read LARGE figure labeling the line either in the top or bottom margin, or on the line itself.
12T	3. Estimate tenths from grid line to point.
12T	4. Locate first HORIZONTAL grid line BELOW point and read LARGE figure labeling the line either in the left or right margin, or on the line itself.
12T	5. Estimate tenths from grid line to point.
12T	6. Combine the four figures and add 100,000 to the first figure to give the point's location in meters.
12T	7. Example: 4457000
