LEGEND SIGNOS CONVENCIONALES. A detailed legend listing symbols for populated places, roads, railroads, boundaries, and relief features. It includes symbols for various types of roads, railroads, and terrain features, along with their corresponding map symbols.

NOTES NOTAS. A section containing various notes and conventions for the map, including information about elevations, contour intervals, and map projections. It also includes a glossary of terms used in the map.
