National forest boundaries represent proclamation lines and do not necessarily imply Federal jurisdiction.

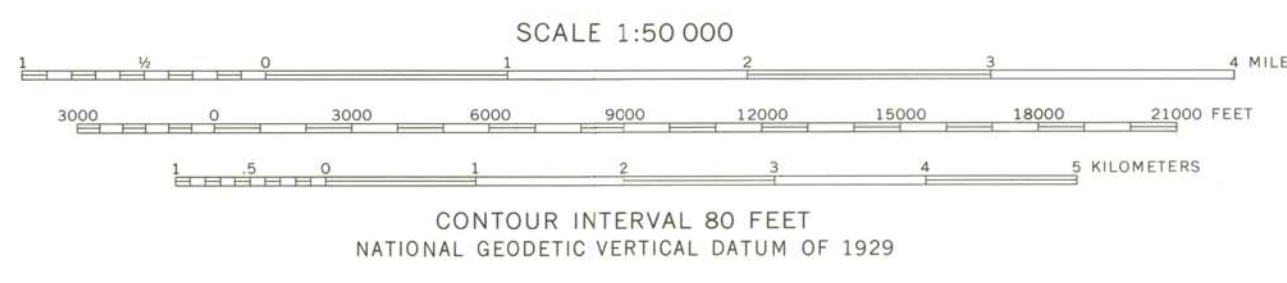
