EXPLANATION

TRAIL OR ROAD—Dashed where approximately located, dotted where inferred. Plotted from aerial photographs, General Land Office files, or early maps. Non-road or road names are from original sources such as ledgers or government road structures. However, the names Mountain Ranch and Cimarron Creek are newly added from early trail maps as no other. Some trails are terminated where continuations are not visible on the aerial photographs.

TRAIL OR ROAD—Dotted or dashed. —Approximately located, otherwise approximately shown. Names used and approximate date of founding or of activity. Most trail names especially newer ones, are shown on base map. Locations of towns shown on present maps are visible, and locations used here map for convenience.

ROAD—Abandoned and dismantled. It runs in parentheses when in an additional name under which a railroad was built or operated. Date shown beginning or duration of operation. Operating railroads are shown on base map. They abandoned railroads are shown on page. For three dated about railroads see Series 1700 and 1710.
