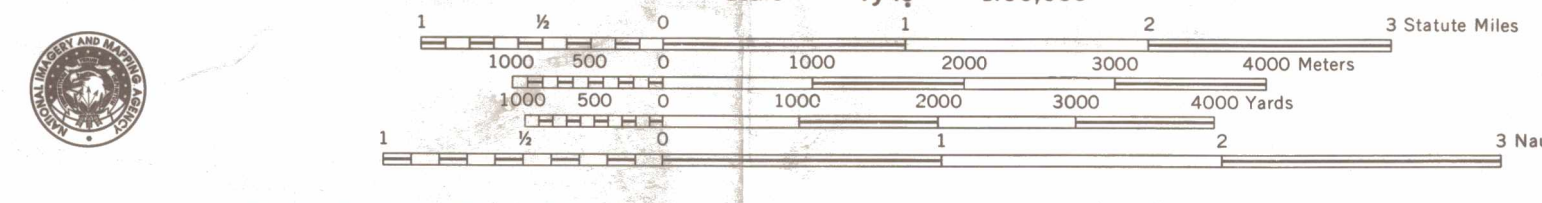




LEGEND - CHỮ TỰ

- MAP INFORMATION AS OF 1969
On this map a LANE is considered as being a minimum of 2.4 m (8 feet) in width.
Dense forest or jungle indicates more than 25 percent of ground is covered by canopy with undergrowth generally impassable on foot.
When referring to populated place names, include UTM grid coordinates and the number in parentheses following a populated place name indicates more than one place is so named within the map sheet area.
