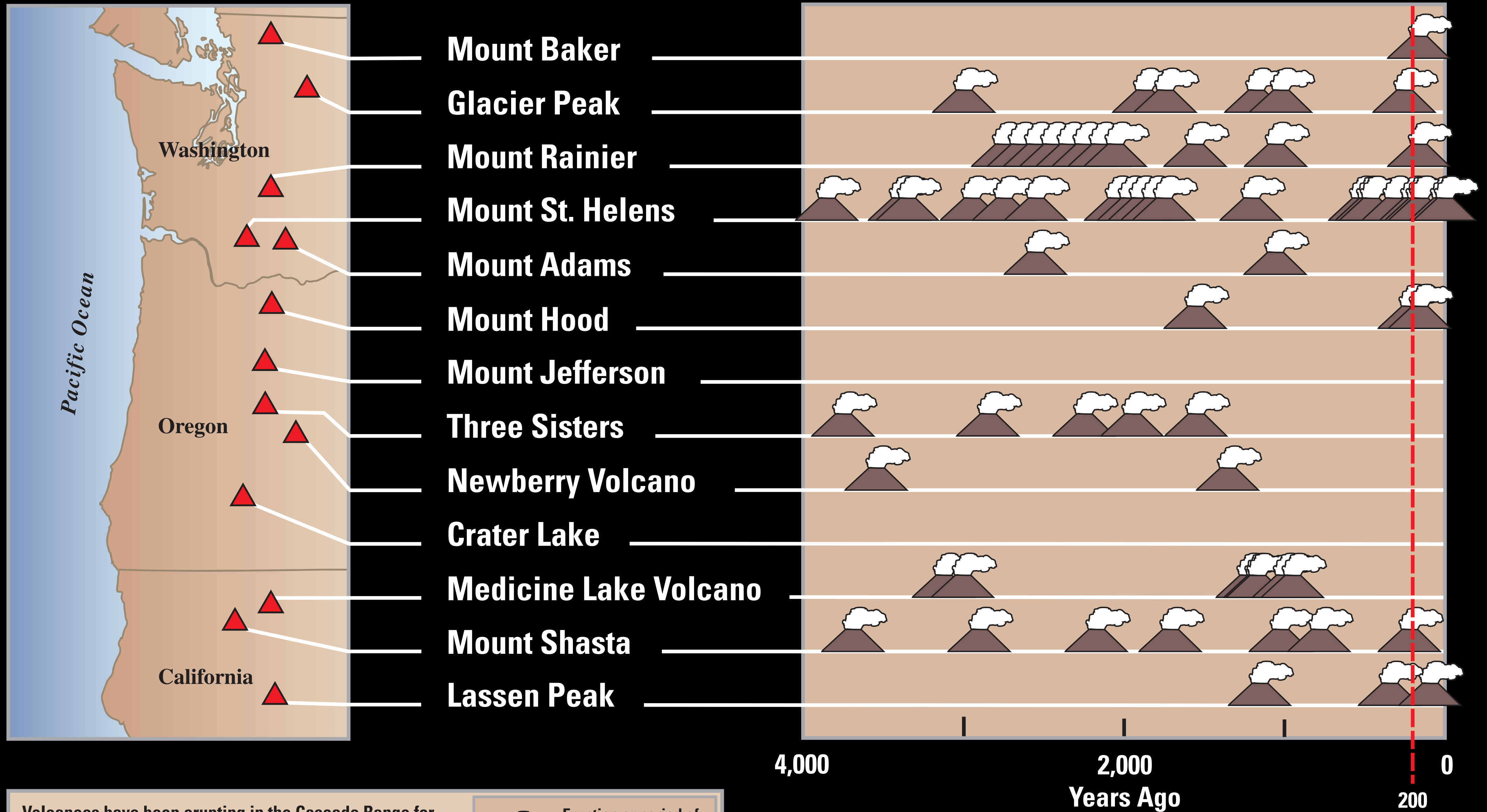


Eruptions in the Cascade Range During the Past 4,000 Years
